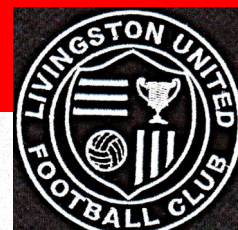

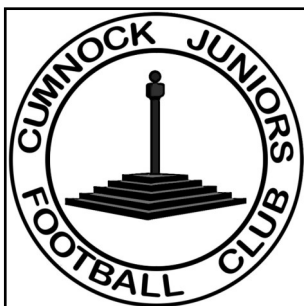
Chris Dallas opens the scoring against Livingston with a powerful header

## Glenafton Athletic 8 (3) Livingston 1 (0)

McBoookie.com Super Premier Division: Match 05

Saturday 8th October 2016 | Loch Park, New Cumnock



Glens cruised into the 3rd round of the Scottish Junior Cup with an emphatic win over Livingston United who gave their all from start to finish. **Chris Dallas** opened the scoring on 12 minutes after leaping to meet David Gray's corner kick and bullet home a header from 8 yards outs. Five minutes later **Dallas** doubled the lead after fine build up play ended wide on the left for Joe Andrew to whip the ball across the face of goal and the big striker side on to the goal coolly flicked the ball past the rooted keeper. Chances continued to come Glenafton's way and on 39 minutes they extended their lead with the goal of the game when **David Gray** collected the ball inside the D of the penalty box and before chipping the ball with perfect weight and pin-point accuracy to float it over a host of players and let it drop between the narrow space of the bar and the outstretched arm of the forlorn keeper.

**Chris Dallas** bagged his hat-trick from close range while half-time teas were still heating the hands of supporters from both sides. Gallant Livingston struck back within four minutes after a corner-kick saw the ball bobble about a ruck of players in the six yard box and the never-say-die **Kieran McKee** was first to react to leather the ball into the roof of the net, to make it 4-1. Glens brought on the fresh legs of Mick McCann and Darren McGill for Chris Dallas and Dan Orsi. Ten minutes later Andrew was the architect again and from deep in the left hand side of the box he picked out **McGill** to blast the ball past keeper Mark McArthur from 8 yards out to make it 5-1 after 69 minutes. Another pair of fresh legs saw Andrew Hunter replace Cameron Marlow as the Glens continued to press. On 71 minutes McArthur made a fine save from McCann to turn the ball behind and from Gray's resultant corner-kick **Ryan McChesney** headed home from deep inside the six yard box. With 5 minutes to go **Gray** bagged his brace with a late run into the box to pick up a Craig Menzies pass and without breaking his stride whacked an unstoppable shot home from 15 yards to make it 7-1. Two minutes later McChesney chased down an over-hit free-kick on the left hand-side of the box and wheeled round to play a one-two with McCann before trying to pick out Ally Park at the back post only for the ball to elude his team-mate and make its way to goal before a defender got a final touch on the line but couldn't prevent **McChesney's** double.

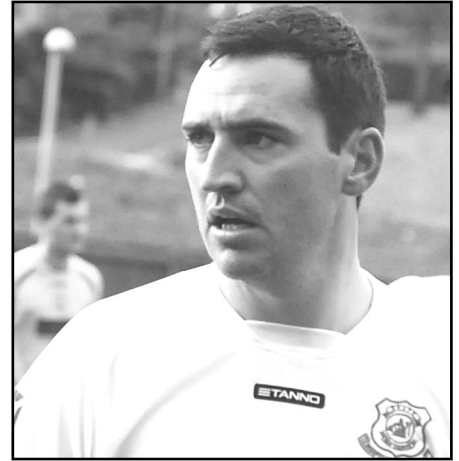


# Welcome to CUMNOCK JUNIORS

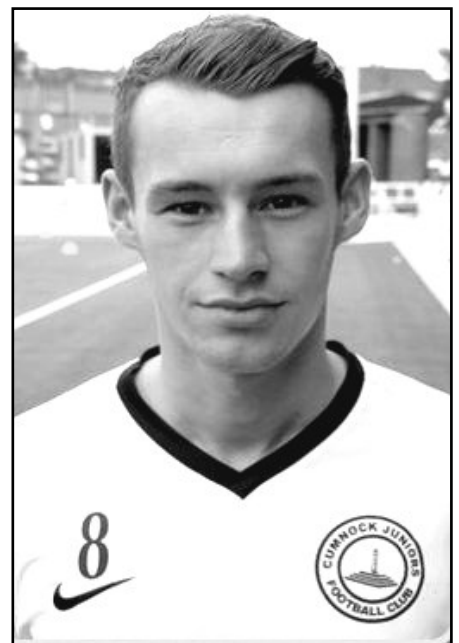


## SEASON 2016/17: Back in the Top Flight

A huge transformation at Townhead has been matched a host of new faces in the Cumnock playing squad. A familiar face is of course goalkeeper **David Buchanan** (middle right) who joined from Glenafton.



On a personal note another familiar face (Ok when he was about 3 years old) is a former Barrhead neighbour 21 year old midfielder **Andy Muir** (bottom right) who had spells with St. Mirren and Ayr United. Also in midfield is **Adam Hunter** who began his career with Rangers before moving to Ayr United and then to Arbroath along with **Callum McRobbie** who was at Aberdeen as a youth and later played for Shettleston and Albion Rovers. A further addition to the middle of the park in **Mark Williams** who has experience in the seniors at Alloa , St.Mirren and Queen's Park.



Up front and returning to Townhead is striker **Scott Anson**, one on Killie's his list of Junior clubs include Bo'ness, Neilston Petershill, and more recently Shettleston. Joining from Ayr United is 19 year old **Sean McKenzie** (right, bottom) from Sanquhar and adding to the strike force in 31 year old Stephen Auld well known in the amateur ranks with Netherthird and Hurlford Thistle. Also joining the 'Nock from the amateurs is 17 year old **TJ Shirkie**, who also had a spell with Kilmarnock youths.

## SEASON 2016/17 So Far

Cumnock's Ardagh Cup campaign with Scot Anson bagging 4 goals in a 6-0 defeat of Lugar Boswell with William Wells (now on loan at Maryhil) and Andy Muir opening their Townhead accounts. Anson and Wells were on target in the 3-1 at Kello with TJ Shirkie grabbing the other goal. Scott Anson cancelled out Auchinleck's lead at Beechwood to earn a share of the points. All three points were won at Loch Park as Callum McRobbie and Stephen Auld found the net while Glens Darren McGill and David Gray took turns at the early bath. The section matches were concluded with a 7-0 mauling of Muirkirk and Anson finishing how he had began with another 4 goals ; an Auld brace and a single from McRobbie completing the scoring. In a thrilling Quarter-final under the floodlights at Townhead the home side came from behind to defeat Girvan 3-2—with a Sean McKenzie strike sandwiched between an Anson double. Scott Anson fired his 13th goal of the competition but unlucky for some it was not enough to overcome Kilbirnie in the semi-final at Valefield, the home side winning 2-1 before going on to defeat Auchinleck 1-0 in the final.

It would be mixed fortunes in the other cup competitions. Cumnock's Scottish Junior Cup aspirations when up in flames in the 1st round at the Beltane home to 'Nock's manager John McKeown's former side Wishaw—the Central District 1st Division side recording a shock 2-0 victory. The West of Scotland Cup 1st round provided a more favourable result with Clydebank comfortably beaten 4-0 at Townhead - Del Esplin opening the scoring before Anson's brace and Mark Williams hitting the fourth.

The league campaign kicked-off with a hard trip to Beith and it the home side that claimed the points and a clean-sheet. McRobbie cancelled out Rob Roy's lead only for the visitors to add two more. Paul Burns halved the deficit before being sent off the Rabs scoring a decisive fourth goal. Fellow promotees were next to visit Townhead and were no match for the home side who claimed their first points of the season with a convincing 4-0 win— a Sean McKenzie double in the first half followed in the second with goals from Paul Burns and Andy Muir.

The trip to Dunterlie proved a greater challenge. Although that man Anson cancelled out Arthurlie's lead it was the Barrhead side that came out on top with two more goals without reply. After a share of the points in the Ardagh Cup game with Auchinleck the league encounter at Beechwood ended disappointingly. Anson missed the opportunity to halve the deficit from the spot after the home side had taken a 2-0 lead and Auchinleck went on to score a third.

The back-to-back defeats away from home were countered by back-to-back home wins. Kilwinning Ranger, another of Cumnock's fellow promotees, were no match for the home side on the day. Goals from Keiren Wood, Sean McKenzie and Paul Burns put the 'Nock three-nil at the break. McKenzie struck again after the break before the Buffs found a consolation. Two former Glens goalies, David uchanan and Ally Semple faced each as Troon came calling to Townhead and it was David that came out on top with a clean sheet while Scott Anson and Keir Samson got the better of Ally.
